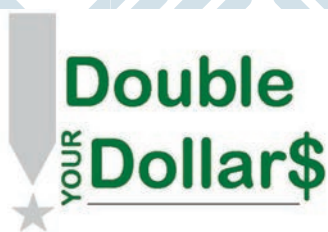

Homes from the Heart Apartment Shelter Program

Love INC's Family Apartment Shelter Program, Homes from the Heart, was launched in January of 2022. Our county does not have any homeless shelters, so we were thrilled to offer temporary housing to those in need. The shelter program includes the opportunity for our participants to assess their own self-sufficiency, set their own goals, receive a case manager, and a volunteer mentor to walk beside them for up to a year. Children of those in the apartment shelters receive enrichment activities at the same time as their parents take classes that help them recognize their unique value and potential in God's eyes. Participants also take classes that assist with budgeting and setting boundaries. The average stay is 3 -6 months as participants save money and develop skills to find permanent housing. Love INC's ultimate goal is to launch these families into independence by comprehensive case management & mentoring, emotional support, and Christ's love.
