**We love our Volunteers!**




## Homes from the Heart

Homes from the Heart, our apartment shelter ministry, started in January of last year. Four families have been placed in this program that allows families to start over after they have fallen on hard times. The average stay is around 6 months. Those needing supportive services may stay longer as they get their families back on track. During their time in the shelters, families receive mentoring, comprehensive case management, and attend faith-based classes that focus on their future potential, setting boundaries, and financial planning. We have seen lives changed and families move toward independence. Homes from the Heart allows our church community to support these families in similar ways as a biological family would...to come around them and show God's love.



Please consider giving \$16 per month to keep these shelters open and to hire a part-time program manager.
